

MAIN PROJECT FIRST PAGE

CREATE A WELL DESIGNED FIRST PAGE REQUIREMENTS

WORK THAT IS NOT ON THE SERVER BEFORE CLASS ON THE DUE DATE WILL NOT RECEIVE A GRADE

DOC TYPE: xhtml strict
STYLE SHEET: must be linked
META TAGS: author, description, key words

W3C: You are required to get W3C validation
Provide a link from the Portal page to this site (DO NOT LINK THE SITE BACK TO THE PORTAL PAGE)

DIMENSIONS: Must adhere to the current industry standards for the dimensions for a web page

FIRST PAGE: Cannot be a splash page

INTRODUCTION: Include an introductory statement

TEXT CANNOT USE

Lorem Ipsum for: Introductory statement, Titles, Sub Titles, First line of each paragraph, Content of table
You cannot use content from another source (the Internet, books magazines etc.) but you can work with a writer and use their copy.

DESIGN: Design must be liquid for content and top banner

Must include reworked banner and menu

You can use Photographs but no composite images from another source

All photographs must be credited in your Process Book and your final Credits Page

You cannot use any drawings, maps charts etc from another source you must create your own

Do not use any gradients

Try to use only three colors maximum four

No black or Dark Grey backgrounds

DO NOT PLACE IMAGES IN THEIR OWN DIVS they can stand alone, have the content float around each image

Content images need borders (hardly noticeable) and must have adequate margins.

FONTS: The title/logo font must be appropriate for the audience and topic

Use sans serif font for your content. Your choice of font for your content should be one that is common to all computers

LINKS: You must have a global menu

If you use images for the menu you must use css for rollovers

Links need CSS styles

COPYRIGHT:

You are required to read the copyright handout and adhere to its contents.

You can use images from Getty Images but you must be login as a student.

You can get the password and user name from the library.

All images from Getty Images must be documented in your Process Book. Each image must be listed separately and represented by a thumbnail image.

BROWSERS / PLATFORM

Must work in all browsers and both platforms

PRESENTATION

Be prepared to present to a group of students and the instructor
